**Bob McCulloch**

After the non-indictment of Darren Wilson, Bob McCulloch admitted that he knowingly allowed witnesses to give false testimonies during the grand jury proceedings related to Michael Brown's death.

Faith leaders have called on McCulloch to eliminate money bail, and he has refused to put an end to this unjust system that keeps low income people behind bars.

In response to protesters chanting "Black Lives Matter," at an event after Darren Wilson's non-indictment, McCulloch said "I'm pretty certain all lives matter."

Under McCulloch's leadership, the death penalty has been disproportionately used against Black people in St. Louis County.



**Wesley Bell**

As a Councilman, Bell worked directly with the Department of Justice on community policing and court reform initiatives for the city of Ferguson.

Bell supports bail reform. He wants to shift the culture of the prosecuting attorney's office to one that centers transparency and community trust.

When asked about prosecuting protestors, Wesley Bell said, "I would rather fight to give them a reason not to protest."
